## Instructions for patients following grommet surgery

Your child will remain in hospital for observation for a short period after surgery and will be discharged when stable.

## When you get home:

- Very occasionally patients complain of pain or pressure following surgery. If your child complains of pain or pressure, administer Paracetamol according to their age, weight and instructions on your particular brand of medication. If experienced, this pain or pressure should subside within 24 hours.
- Give your child a *light diet* on the day of surgery on return home and progress them to a normal diet the next day.
- You may notice some discharge from the operated ears. Don't insert anything into the
  ear canal to clean this away, and only wipe away any discharge which may make its way
  onto the outer part of the ear or face.
- Prior to surgery we recommend that you obtain suitable ear plugs for use immediately following the surgery for bathing, showers, water play and sand play. Our recommended brand is Docs Pro Plugs and our practice can inform you of your local supplier. Swimming is not recommended until at least after the first post operative appointment with Dr Para. When swimming activities are recommenced there is to be no diving, jumping or "bombing" into water and ear plugs are to be used at all times while participating.
- Participation in school or child care activities can be recommenced 24 hours after discharge from hospital.
- *Medical certificates* for patients and/or carers can be obtained by calling the rooms on 4737 3396.
- Nepean Public Hospital patients a follow up appointment will be conducted at the outpatients clinic and Dr Para will indicate the time frame.
- <u>Westmead Private Hospital patients</u> *a follow up appointment* has already been arranged. Please review your letter from the practice or check with our medical secretary on 4737 3396
